When Independent Futures closed our office to the public in March, none of us knew how long we would be gone or how quickly we would need to adapt. Since then, our supports have changed alongside state and federal health guidelines. To adapt:

- Independent Futures participant activities successfully moved to Zoom meetings.
- The Direct Service team held tutoring sessions virtually and in-person while following social distancing guidelines.
- My Full Life's remote learning opportunities have helped agencies across the country continue their services.
- New Futures Initiative curriculum is being adapted to support virtual family group trainings.

Though we have been able to continue providing supports with very limited interruptions for more than 6 months, we need your help to fund supporting full lives through the next year. Will you continue to support our work in creating access to independent lives today?

Each time Illinois' government announced new guidelines, our Direct Service team quickly communicated the new information to our community.
